"Love Lifted Me" was written and published in 1912. It gained popularity among United Methodists as one of the frequently sung songs in *The Cokesbury Hymnal*.

Author James Rowe (1865-1933) was born in England, the son of a copper miner. He immigrated to the United States from Ireland in 1889.

His text uses images from two biblical stories. The first is found in Matthew 14:22-33, where Peter left the boat to join Jesus walking on the water. He began to sink and was saved by Jesus. The second story is found in Matthew 8:23-27, in which Jesus is asleep in the boat while the disciples are terrified by the fierce storm threatening to plunge them all into the sea. They wake Jesus and appeal to him. Jesus rebukes the wind and sea, and there is calm.

Rowe's text skillfully draws on both stories, using sinking or being swamped into the sea as an image for "sinking deep in sin...sinking to rise no more." Jesus, "Master of the sea," hears our cry for help, reaches out to us in love, and lifts us up into the safety of salvation.
